

# Orwell & Portmoak Calendar Competition

The title for the Orwell & Portmoak Calendar for next year is “**2020 Vision**” and all proceeds from the sale of the calendars will go towards the Orwell & Portmoak Buildings Improvement Project.

We’re looking for beautiful photographs that show off our local area throughout the seasons - whether buildings, plants, animals or countryside.

Competition rules are as follows:

1. The closing date for the competition is **23:59 on 31<sup>st</sup> August 2019**.
2. There will be three age groups: Up to 12, 13-17 and 18 and over.
3. You can enter up to three photos in total. Each photo must be in JPEG format and should be of sufficiently high resolution to produce a good quality A4 print. Please also include the title of each photograph in its file name.
4. All entries must be the original work of the entrant.
5. You will retain copyright in the photographs that you submit to the competition, but by entering the competition you are giving permission for them to be published in the calendar.
6. Your entries should be emailed to [opcalendarcompetition@gmail.com](mailto:opcalendarcompetition@gmail.com).
7. The email accompanying your entries, must also include your contact details (name, address and telephone number) together with the title of each of your photos. You should also state which of the three age groups your entries relate to.

If you are under the age of 18, the email must be sent by your parent or guardian.

8. The photographs will be judged at a community event where the entries will be displayed digitally and those attending will have the opportunity to vote for their favourite pictures. The four most popular photographs in each age group after judging will appear in the calendar.
9. The sole prize for each winning entry will be its inclusion in the calendar.
10. To enter the competition you will have provided us with your personal data including your photographic entry. Following publication of the calendar, all emails containing entries and personal information will be destroyed.
